According to Nicky Ladas, Chief Technologist at Cumulus VFX, most of the organization's IT challenges came down to storage capacity—a common problem in the industry as technology demands grow. "There was no overhead left on our old storage subsystem," explains Ladas. "We had hit the wall from a capacity and performance point of view."

Specifically helping Cumulus VFX manage applications such as Houdini, Blender, Autodesk Maya, Sihouette FX, 3D Equalizer, and Adobe Photoshop.

As Chris Dawson, Director at <u>Agile Data Services</u> says, "Not only is data security paramount, so is the ability to avoid outages. If Cumulus VFX had an outage while doing massive workloads with developers, it would be a catastrophe."

"Pure Storage is already making a big difference in our ability to scale and remain agile," says Ladas. "For instance, we're doing work on massive ocean simulations, which require high performance storage and compute. With Pure, we gained a magnitude of performance difference in our outputs."

Meeting Obligations to the Planet

Even while expanding its data centre, Pure Storage enabled Cumulus VFX to minimize carbon emissions with higher rack density and improved performance.

"What Pure Storage provides in four or six units would take competitors 96 units," says Ladas. "I think there's an obligation for us decision makers to put the most efficient, lowest impact solutions in place. Pure Storage not only ticked all the performance and technical requirements, but it had the best energy footprint. The decision was a no-brainer. Pure is leaps ahead of the competition."

Taking on Top Global Productions

Cumulus VFX plans to expand its relationship with Pure Storage and Agile Data Services to support the overall growth of its business.

"We're already talking about doubling simulations," says Ladas. "I also want to bring in Pure Storage FlashArray to support our virtualized infrastructure, including VDI for remote users.
